Leading mayoral candidates have been invited to discuss a number of critical issues facing New Yorkers, including housing affordability, federal funding, zoning reform, and affordable housing development. Candidates will also address the growing homelessness crisis in New York City.

Moderated by **NY1's Errol Louis**, the forum will be a data-driven, policy-focused discussion where candidates will discuss their proposed solutions to address New York City's affordable housing needs and homelessness.
